






Where Do Your Donations Go?

Your support ensures that the children in our care receive a daily lunch and a proper education for the rest of the year. For those in the most serious situations, your contribution helps us provide a safe haven in our children's home. The chart below shows exactly how your support is changing lives.



From Vulnerable Childhoods to University Halls

Education is the most powerful way to escape poverty. It gives a disadvantaged child a genuine opportunity for future employment and a positive future for their own children as well. Our projects support 1,500 children in primary, secondary and tertiary education, including a special needs school for 80 children with autism.

We're proud of all our students and we don't expect them all to attend university, but we are always thrilled to celebrate those who do. This year, six girls are beginning their university studies in medicine, education, commerce, community development, and economics. We wish them all the best! We're also proud to congratulate our five recent graduates who earned degrees in procurement, community development, science, mathematics, and journalism - with our maths graduate now pursuing a master's degree.











We also have nine students taking their final school exams in October, and we're hopeful they'll qualify for university next year. No matter what path they choose, we're confident they will all have a positive future and contribute meaningfully to their communities and the future of Kenya.

More Disadvantaged Children Get a Hot Daily Meal

Every single school day we serve over 1,600 healthy meals to vulnerable children at our centres. Each meal means better health, better concentration in school, and stronger families. Your support is genuinely life-changing.



A third of our funds is spent on our feeding centres. Improved health and school performance lead to better job opportunities for young adults, promoting independence and self-sufficiency. In 2025, we opened two new feeding centres alongside schools in impoverished communities. Thanks to a recent grant, we will open our 10th centre in 2026, which will feed and transform the lives of another 200-300 children.
